FUNDS WE SUPPORT

- **Annual Fund:** The primary source of funding for district and international projects.
- **SHARE:** How contributions to the Annual Fund go to grants (50% comes back to the district and 50% is used for RI world grants).
- PolioPlus: RI's main project, 100% of PolioPlus donations go towards eradication and all donations are matched 2:1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
- **Endowment Fund:** Donations are invested, only the earnings are used.
- **Permanent Fund:** Donations do not provide recognition to donors (no points to use to make others a Paul Harris Fellow).



QUICK INFO

- The Rotary Foundation is the main funding source for worldwide Rotary work
- Minimum donations of \$100 to Annual Fund and \$25 to PolioPlus each year is encouraged
- You can donate and keep track of your account via the RI website
- **OR** you can include donations with your dues and our Club Treasurer will submit them to RI
- Every Rotary member needs to participate for our club to receive recognition and awards for our work



DONATION GUIDELINES

Every Rotarian is encouraged to contribute to The Rotary Foundation annually. Foundation donations are tax-exempt. Club members receive recognition for donations to the Annual Fund (for grants) and/or PolioPlus (for eradication efforts). Members are asked to contribute to both funds each year - \$100 to the Annual Fund and \$25 to PolioPlus.

- Paul Harris Fellow: Has contributed \$1,000 to the Annual Fund
- Paul Harris Sustaining Member:
 Working on their first \$1,000 in
 contributions to the Annual Fund with
 a minimum contribution of \$100
 annually
- Multiple Paul Harris Fellow: Has contributed \$2,000 or more to the Annual Fund. For each \$1,000 in contributions over the first \$1,000, they can make someone else a Paul Harris Fellow. They can transfer a minimum of 100 points at a time to help another club member attain Paul Harris Fellow status
- Paul Harris Society: Contributes
 \$1,000 annually to the Annual Fund
- **Bequest Society:** Commits for future gifts of \$10,000 or more
- Major Donor: Cumulative donations reach \$10,000
- Arch Klumph Society: Cumulative donations reach \$250,000
- Legacy Society: Commits to a gift of \$1 mil or more to the Endowment fund

OTHER WAYS TO GIVE TO THE ROTARY FOUNDATION:

- **Benefactor:** Include the Endowment Fund as a beneficiary in your estate plan or donate \$1,000 or more to the fund outright
- Memorial and Tribute gifts, set up your own Endowment Fund
- Employer matching gifts, Rotary credit card, Facebook fundraiser



ROTARY FOUNDATION

The Rotary Foundation is the non-profit, taxexempt arm of RI. All donations go to the Foundation. The Foundation manages the funds used by clubs/districts in grants for worldwide service projects. Our district and our club each have their own foundations that work exactly the same way the Rotary Foundation works.

- The District 6780 Foundation can accept donations for district projects or match grants for club projects. It also gets funding from the Rotary Foundation to use for grants.
- The Rotary Club of Oak Ridge Foundation can accept donations for projects its board approves and sets up an internal account for. Some of these will be club projects; some belong to other Rotary clubs or organizations.

CLUB RECOGNITION

Rotary District 6780 Club Recognition/Awards

- \$250+ Club: At least 10% of club members contribute \$200 to Annual Fund and \$50 to PolioPlus
- William T Sergeant Award: Highest per capita giving to the Annual Fund by 03/31
- Star Club Award: Each dues-paying member contributes at least \$100 to the Annual Fund
- William T Sergeant Polio Eradicator Award: Each club member contributes at least \$50 to PolioPlus

Rotary International Club Recognition/Awards

- 100% Paul Harris Fellow Club: all duespaying members are Paul Harris Fellows
- 100% Paul Harris Society Club: each dues-paying member contributes a minimum of \$1,000 to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or global grants in a Rotary year
- 100% Foundation Giving Club: An average of \$10 per dues-paying member and 100% participation with every duespaying member contributing at least \$25 to the Annual Fund PolioPlus, approved global grants or Endowment Fund
- 100% Rotary's Promise Club: Every duespaying member either promises a future gift or gives an outright gift of \$1,000 or more to the Endowment Fund
- Every Rotarian Every Year Club:
 Minimum Annual Fund contribution of \$100
 per capita, with every dues-paying
 member contributing at least \$25
- Top 3 Per Capita in Annual Fund Giving: Be one of the top 3 clubs in the district for Annual Fund giving, with at least \$50 per capita
